## A Good Year of Weevil Ranching

As 2017 comes to a close, GCLA members may want to reflect on what we've accomplished to fulfill our mission of helping Caddo Lake survive whatever man made or natural threats to its existence come along. While the infestation of Giant Salvinia is perhaps the most serious threat since the formation of the lake, despair will get us nowhere, so we continue to work on a solution.

Since September, volunteers have made several releases of salvinia weevils in new areas, some near houses, in the hope that different habitats will be more hospitable through the winter, and the survivors will come back strong in the spring.

The good news is that as the Salvinia scourge spreads to more lakes across the south, more scientists are getting involved and more funding by state and federal authorities will bolster their efforts to develop the longer term bio-control that will take our lakes back. GCLA has actively aided national media (CNN's Great Big Story and National Geographic this year alone) in preparing video documentaries to shine a spotlight on the problem. In the meantime, the dual programs of herbicide spraying and releases of the current version of weevils are providing some relief to keep our lakes alive and somewhat navigable. Have a look at the success in Pine Island Pond. We have a long way to go yet, but if the alternative is complaining and doing nothing, bring on the fight!
