At the August GCLA Board meeting, with their summer internship coming to an end, the students presented a summary of their experiences to the GCLA board and their faculty sponsor, Professor Stephanie Gorski. While doing the more mundane work of tending the weevils in the greenhouse, they collected data and analyzed the relationship between size and location of weevil incubation tanks and weevil production.
